



**TASBURGH SPORTS AND SOCIAL CLUB
BAR HIRE AGREEMENT *TERMS AND CONDITIONS***

PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT

Throughout this Agreement:

- Tasburgh Sports and Social Club CIC (TSSC) is referred to as WE. OUR is construed accordingly. WE and US mean and include employees, volunteers, agents or invitees.
- THE HIRER is referred to as YOU. YOUR is construed accordingly; YOUR also includes employees, volunteers, agents and invitees.

EVENTS

- * Most events are acceptable but WE reserve the right to refuse any booking.
- * WE cannot accept any events for the sale of alcohol.
- * 18th and 21st birthday parties are subject to prior vetting by TSSC.

FEES

- * YOU pay hire fees to Tasburgh Village Hall Management Committee (TVHMC).
- * Corkage fees are £ 3 per bottle or can.
- * Excess corkage fees are £3 per bottle or can.
- * Corkage fees are payable by YOU to US before the day of the event-by cash or card or cheque.
- * If the event is cancelled WE will return the full corkage fee to YOU.
- * Excess corkage fees are payable by YOU to US by cash or card, on the day, if WE agree to allow YOU to serve the excess alcohol.

WELCOME DRINKS/CORKAGE

- * The provision by YOU of a welcome drink and/or a toast drink -must be agreed in advance with US.
- * Any drink YOU supply after a welcome drink and/or a toast drink subject to corkage.
- * The quantity of wine/other alcohol brought in for the event by YOU must be agreed with US at the time of booking.
- * On the day of the event, OUR representative will check that the quantity of alcohol brought in tallies with what was agreed.
- * WE reserve the right to ask YOU to remove any excess over the agreed immediately or risk confiscation by US.
- * If WE agree to allow YOU to serves the excess alcohol -excess corkage will apply.
- * If YOU refuse to pay the excess corkage WE reserve the right to confiscate the excess alcohol.

LICENSE

* WE have a Premises Licence authorising entertainment and the sale of alcohol.

PRESENCE OF HIRER

* YOU agree with US to be present (by your authorised representative, if appropriate) during the hiring and to comply fully with this Agreement.

AGREEMENT

* The Standard Conditions of Hire form part of the terms of this agreement.
* These terms and conditions are in addition to the terms and conditions of the hire agreement between YOU and TVHMC.

STANDARD CONDITIONS OF HIRE

If YOU are in any doubt as to the meaning of any of the Conditions, you must seek clarification from US without delay.

Alcohol

* WE reserve the right to confiscate alcoholic drinks brought on to the premises by YOU.
* YOU must not allow the consumption of alcohol without OUR prior permission.
* Only WE can sell alcoholic drinks on the premises.
* It is illegal for adults to buy/attempt to buy alcohol for anyone under 18.
* It is illegal for anyone under 18 to buy alcohol, attempt to buy alcohol or to be sold alcohol.
* WE reserve the right to refuse to serve alcoholic drinks to any individual.
* WE operate Challenge 25 so reserve the right to check ID from anyone who looks under 25.

Bookings

* WE have total discretion in deciding whether or not to accept bookings for events.
* Completion of the hire form does not constitute a booking confirmation.
* WE will confirm to YOU by email or post OUR acceptance of the booking, via TVHMC.

Closure of the bar

* If WE decide that the safety of any person is at risk or could be at risk, WE reserve the right to immediately close the bar.
* If WE decide that YOU have broken our terms and conditions, WE reserve the right to immediately close the bar.

Drunk and disorderly behaviour and supply of illegal drugs

* YOU must ensure that to avoid disturbing neighbours of the hall and avoid violent or criminal behaviour:

(a) No person attending the event consumes excessive amounts of alcohol.

(b) No illegal drugs are brought onto the premises.

* Drunk and disorderly behaviour is not permitted on the premises or in the vicinity.

* WE will ask any person suspected of being drunk, under the influence of drugs or who is behaving in a violent or disorderly way to leave the premises.

Glasses

* Glasses must be kept inside the hall or on the outside terrace

* Glasses are not allowed on the field or car park

Identity cards

* Where it appears to US that the drinker may be under the age of 25 years, WE are legally required to ask them for identification to prove that they are over the age of 18 and can lawfully purchase alcohol.

* WE reserve the right to ask any person who appears under 25 for proof of age.

* Acceptable proof is a photo driving licence or a proof of age card.

Insurance and indemnity

* YOU are liable for:

(a) The cost of repair of any damage-including accidental and malicious damage-done to any part of the premises, including its contents.

(b) All claims, losses, damages and costs made against or incurred by US, in respect of damage or loss of property or injury to persons arising as a result of YOUR use of the premises.

(d) All claims, losses, damages and costs made against or incurred by US as a result of any nuisance caused to a third party as a result of YOUR use of the premises, and you must indemnify us against such liabilities.
